

Interference Study

The applicant proposes a minor mod of K03IC-D to move to Sutro, just like an identical minor mod was granted for K03HY-D. The applicant intends to have K03HY-D deleted. K03HY-D is the digital companion channel for KQRM-LP, but the applicant intends to flash cut KQRM-LP to digital on channel 2. This means that K03HY-D will therefore be deleted. K03IC-D will take its place on channel 3.

The applicant has a reciprocal interference waiver agreement with KCSO-LD, which has been attached. The engineer for KCSO-LD did an interference analysis between the existing interference from KCSO-LD at its licensed facility compared to the recently granted move of KCSO-LD into Sacramento, and the interference is expected to be reduced between K03IC-D and KCSO-LD for this proposed minor mod of K03IC-D and the minor mod recently granted for KCSO-LD. The applicant also has a waiver agreement with Joseph Fiori, owner of K04RS-D, Facility ID 182086. Also, an application has been filed by Joseph Fiori to sell K04RS-D to One Ministries, Inc., but the assignment application has not yet been granted yet. The applicant is owner of all of the other stations that would receive interference from this proposed move. Those stations include KTVJ-LD, KQRO-LD, K02QP, and KQRM-LP.
