

ANNUAL EEO PUBLIC FILE REPORT

During the Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters, the station hosted 15 interns from Butler University, University of Indianapolis, Ball State University, IUPUI, Belmont University, Franklin College, and Indiana University.

Internship and employment opportunities were discussed with potential applicants.
