TECHNICAL SUMMARY APPLICATION FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT TELEVISION STATION KBEH(TV) (CHANNEL SHARE) CHANNEL 42 486 KW (MAX-DA) 892 M HAAT

- 1. The instant application is a 'Channel-Share' application for digital television station KBEH(TV), Oxnard, CA (Channel 24), which is a winning bidder in the FCC's Incentive Auction to relinquish its radiofrequency spectrum. Through the channel-share agreement with the licensee of KWHY-TV, Los Angeles, CA, KBEH will initially broadcast its channel-share programming on Channel 42. It is noted that KWHY-TV has been reassigned to Channel 4 as part of its winning bid in the Incentive Auction and it will itself migrate to that channel in the future within its given phase transition timeline.
- 2. Because KBEH's current city of license of Oxnard, CA, is not within the predicted 48 dBu, f(50,90), principal community contour of the Channel-42 facility, the community of Garden Grove has been specified as the new city of license for KBEH.
- 3. The city of Garden Grove is an incorporated community of 171,165 persons* with no licensed full-service DTV stations assigned to it. This community is equivalent to Oxnard under the FCC television allotment priorities since KBEH will provide a first local television service to this community. In addition, Garden Grove is located within the same Nielsen Designated Market Area (DMA) as Oxnard, which is Los Angeles, CA.
- 4. The instant proposal is compliant with the city coverage requirements of Garden Grove. This is illustrated in the Predicted Coverage Contours exhibit (Figure 1).
