UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA Fee Exemption

The licensee is the University of North Carolina, which is a body politically created by the North Carolina General Assembly, see *N.C.G.S.* § 116-3, and is composed of sixteen public universities. It is administered by a Board of Governors which is appointed by the General Assembly. Accordingly, the licensee is a political organization controlled by duly appointed public officials exercising sovereign direction and control and, therefore, constitutes a governmental entity exempt from the payment of application fees. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.1114(f).
