

### **Community of License Change**

As reflected in this application, TCCSA, Inc., d/b/a Trinity Broadcasting Network (“Trinity”) has entered into a channel sharing agreement pursuant to which the Station will broadcast from the facilities currently licensed to WLPD-CD, Plano, Illinois. Operating from the WLPD-CD transmission site, the Station will not satisfy the community of license signal requirements at its current community of license, La Salle, Illinois. Trinity therefore respectfully requests that the Commission substitute Naperville, Illinois, for La Salle as the community of license for WWTO-TV.

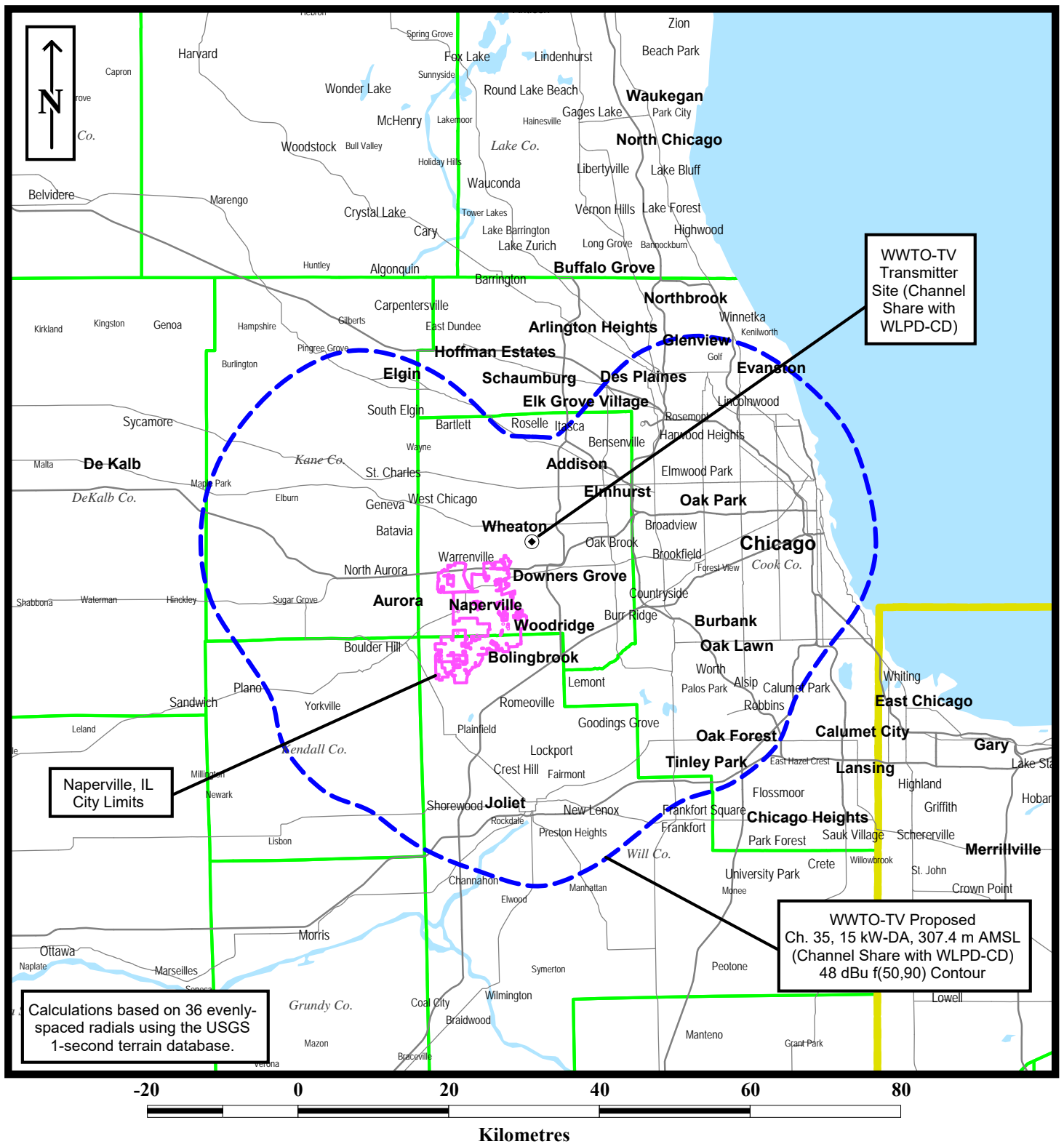
In the Incentive Auction Report and Order, the Commission stated that it would permit a sharee to change its community of license in situations where (i) the sharee cannot meet community of license signal requirements operating from the sharer’s transmission site, (ii) the sharee chooses a new community of license that, at a minimum, meets the same allotment priorities as its current community, and (iii) the sharee proposes a community of license within its DMA.<sup>1</sup> All three conditions are satisfied here:

- WWTO-TV cannot meet community of license signal requirements for La Salle, Illinois, operating from the transmission site of WLPD-CD but, as demonstrated in the attached map, it can meet the signal requirements for Naperville, Illinois.
- Like La Salle, Illinois, Naperville, Illinois qualifies as a “priority two” community because WWTO-TV will be the only full-power television broadcast service licensed to the community.<sup>2</sup> Naperville – the fifth-largest city in Illinois – had a population of 141,853 as of the 2010 Census.
- Naperville, Illinois, like La Salle, Illinois, is located within the Chicago, Illinois, Designated Market Area.
