Long Term Recruitment Initiatives

Internship Program

Internship Program – Internships at WYCC are available to undergraduates and well as graduate students in any field related to Television, Media Production, Communications, Creative Marketing, Business Writing, Design, and Engineering. We have at least twelve (15) Interns each year in Television Production, Membership, Interactive and Creative Services. Our Internship program includes diverse students from City Colleges of Chicago, Northwestern University, Columbia College, Roosevelt University and other highly regarded educational institutions.



Events with educational institutions

WYCC has implemented programs to encourage professional experiences by students:

Student Production Assistant Program – The Student Production Assistant (PA) Program was implemented specifically for those students interested in hands-on production experience. Student PAs work directly with the WYCC Production staff on local productions and field shoots. Students completed over 1,600 hours in the Production Assistant Program during the 2016/2017 school year.

KKC Student Shadow Program – This program was initiated by Kennedy-King College's Media Communications Department in partnership with WYCC in an effort to introduce students to experts in their field of study. It provides them with an in-depth look into various positions at the station. In addition, students must complete a required number of hours in this program in order to pass the class.
