RE: Non-Objection to Predicted Interference from Channel 15 Operations by
WILM-LD, Wilmington, NC (FIN 167819)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

WRAZ-TV, Inc. is the licensee of WRAZ(TV), Raleigh, North Carolina (FIN 64611) ("WRAZ"). WRAZ-TV, Inc. is under common ownership with WILM, Inc., the licensee of digital low power television station WILM-LD, Wilmington, North Carolina (FIN 167819) ("WILM-LD").

WRAZ has been issued a construction permit to operate on channel 15 for its post-auction channel (File No. 0000025194). WILM-LD is submitting a displacement application and Special Temporary Authority request in order to move to channel 15, in light of T-Mobile's notification of its intent to commence operations on WILM-LD's present channel (channel 40). There is predicted interference of 1.05% from WILM-LD's proposed channel 15 operations with respect to the WRAZ construction permit, and of 1.04% with respect to the WRAZ baseline reassignment facility (FCC DTVBL64611).

By this letter, WRAZ-TV, Inc. notifies the Commission of its non-objection to WILM-LD's operations in Wilmington on channel 15, and WRAZ's acceptance of the predicted interference outlined above.
