

PURPOSE OF WCWJ 1st PRIORITY FILING WINDOW FILING

Graham Media Group (GMG), licensee of the WCWJ-DT Jacksonville, FL facility, timely filed an “Unable to Construct” waiver which was granted by the FCC. Accordingly, pursuant to FCC rules, the WCWJ-DT Channel 20 post-auction facility is eligible to file in the First Priority Filing Window. In order for the WCWJ-DT Channel 18 facility to buildout its post transition facility, it will need to change site locations from the licensed WCWJ tower to the WJXT tower which owned by GMG. The WJXT site is located only 0.58 miles from the WCWJ site. Accordingly, this application requests the following changes in order to buildout its post-transition facility and to maximize coverage:

- Change site locations from WCWJ tower to WJXT tower
- Change azimuth pattern from trilobe to cardioid to share antennas with WJXT
- Increase ERP to 1,000 kW

GMG met with the FCC to discuss these changes and the plan that was presented to the FCC is included as an attachment in this application so that additional details can be accessed if needed.
