

REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY (STA)

TRANSLATOR STATION K41KS-D
SEILING, OKLAHOMA
CHANNEL 21 0.5 KW 679.2 M AMSL

1. Due to the imminent displacement of K41KS-D, Tribune Broadcasting Oklahoma City License, LLC (“Tribune”) respectfully requests a waiver of the Displacement Freeze to allow it to continue its operations on Channel 21 by means of Special Temporary Authority (STA). This is pursuant to the FCC’s *Public Notice* providing tools available to LPTV/Translator stations displaced prior to the Special Displacement Window for LPTV/Translator stations.*
2. This waiver is requested to allow Tribune to file an application for construction permit for displacement on Channel 21 and to file for STA for operation as proposed in that application.
3. The K41KS-D facility is licensed for operation on RF Channel 41.
4. Tribune was notified by letter that the 600 MHz Band wireless band licensee in the market, T-Mobile, will be commencing operations that will result in the early displacement of the K41KS-D facility prior to the Special Displacement Window for LPTV/Translator stations. The letter from T-Mobile is included as an exhibit.
5. Grant of this waiver will allow K41KS-D to continue to provide service to the public with as little disruption to its viewers as possible.
6. The licensee is filing a displacement application for Channel 21 that demonstrates compliance with the FCC’s processing and interference protection requirements as outlined in the FCC’s *Public Notice*.
