

PURPOSE OF WWUP MINOR MODIFICATION APPLICATION

Heritage Broadcasting Company of Michigan (“Heritage”) is the licensee of the WWUP-DT Channel 10 Sault Ste. Marie, MI facility which was not assigned a new channel in the recent FCC repack, and therefore, was not part of the post-incentive auction repack process. Accordingly, pursuant to DA 17-1086, WWUP is timely filing a maximization application to increase the WWUP-DT Channel 10 facility’s noise-limited contour in one or more azimuthal directions beyond the station's authorized facilities.

Proposed Changes:

- Increase the WWUP-DT Channel 10 facility’s power from the licensed ERP of 25 kW to the proposed ERP of 106 kW using the licensed (existing) nondirectional antenna.
- Change antennas from nondirectional to directional
