This letter is in reference to the requests for waiver (service rule waiver requests) filed by WatchTV, Inc. (WatchTV), concerning the above captioned stations. In lieu of reimbursement for its assigned post-auction channel changes, WatchTV filed two service rule waiver requests pursuant to Section 6403(b)(4)(B) of the Spectrum Act and Section 1.3 of the Rules in order to make flexible use of its post-auction television channels.<sup>1</sup> On December 14, 2017, WatchTV filed a request seeking dismissal its service rule waiver requests. Accordingly, we **GRANT** WatchTV's request and **DISMISS** the service rule waiver requests (File Nos. 0000024542 and 0000024543).
