

**Request for Special Temporary Authority  
WXBU (Fac. ID No. 23338) Lancaster, Pennsylvania  
HSH Lancaster (WLYH) Licensee, LLC**

By this submission, HSH Lancaster (WLYH) Licensee, LLC (“HSH Licensee”), the licensee of WXBU (Fac. ID No. 23338), Lancaster, Pennsylvania (the “Station”) requests authority and waiver from certain notification requirements of Section 73.3700 of the Commission’s rules, to the extent necessary as described below. WXBU is a channel sharing station that relinquished its spectrum in the Broadcast Incentive Auction, and has been granted a channel sharing construction permit to share with WHP-TV (File No. 0000035536). Due to financial and programming related considerations regarding continued operations, and to ensure uninterrupted programming services to the public, WXBU plans to implement the channel share on December 29, 2017 (given that December 31 is a Sunday); however, it has not yet begun airing its consumer education notifications or notifying MVPDs of the Station’s channel change. As a result, HSH Licensee respectfully requests this waiver to the extent necessary under the circumstances.

HSH Licensee commits to do the following in lieu of full compliance with Section 73.3700(c)(3) and (d) and in support of the waiver grant requested herein:

- WXBU commits to air the required PSAs and crawls in accordance not only with Section 73.3700(c)(3) of the Commission’s rules, but also in accordance with the more stringent notification requirements of Section 73.3700(c)(1);
- WXBU commits to air an additional 60 seconds per day of on-air consumer education PSAs or crawls prior to the date the station terminates operations on its pre-auction channel;
- WXBU commits to notify all impacted MVPDs in the manner and containing the information required by provisions of Section 73.3700(d) of the Commission’s rules as soon as possible after the filing of the instant waiver request;
- For a period of seven days following commencement of shared operations with WHP-TV (and beginning on January 2, 2018), HSH Licensee will place an advertisement in a local daily newspaper that is distributed within WXBU’s community of license informing viewers of (i) WXBU’s change in channel, instructing viewers how to continue to view WXBU’s programming both over-the-air and via MVPD, and (ii) instructing viewers how to obtain more information by telephone or online; and
- For a period of thirty days following commencement of shared operations with WHP-TV, WXBU commits to maintain information on its website and via its social media platforms informing viewers of WXBU’s change in channel, instructing viewers how to continue to view WXBU’s programming both over-the-air and via MVPD and how viewers may obtain more information by telephone and/or online.
