

RESUMPTION OF OPERATIONS AT REDUCED POWER

WELU DT LOST ITS TOWER DURING HURRICANE MARIA ON SEPTEMBER 20, 2017; A SILENT STA WAS FILED WITH THE FCC. WELU HAS ENTERED INTO A CHANNEL SHARING AGREEMENT WITH WSJN-CD, WHICH HAS BEEN ABLE TO PARTIALLY RECONSTRUCT ITS TOWER AND ANTENNA SYSTEM (LOST DURING HURRICANE MARIA) AND RESTORE A LOW POWER OPERATION TO PROVIDE A MINIMUM OF SERVICE. WELU HAS FORMALLY REQUESTED A SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS FOR THIS REDUCED POWER OPERATION TO PROVIDE SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC WHILE THE LICENSED FACILITIES OF WSJN-CD ARE RECONSTRUCTED.

WELU IS OPERATING USING THE LICENSED ANTENNA SYSTEM OF WSJN-CD AT A HIGHER ELEVATION (24 MTS INSTEAD OF 6 MTS AGL) BUT WITH SIGNIFICANT LOWER POWER, 3.2 KW ERP (INSTEAD OF 10 KW ERP), THUS THE SERVICE CONTOUR OF THE STATION WILL BE WITHIN ITS LICENSED AUTHORIZED COVERAGE, AS PROPOSED IN THE CONCURRENTLY FILED STA REQUEST.
