

Engineering Statement

Displacement Application W49BE-D Hackettstown, NJ Channel 29 February 2, 2018

Translator station W49BE-D channel 49 Hackettstown, NJ is being displaced due to spectrum repacking related to the recently concluded Incentive Auction. In addition, T-Mobile has notified the licensee of W49BE-D that it must vacate its current spectrum by April 4, 2018 (originally February 4, 2018). In view of this a search for a new channel was undertaken. The result of the channel search is that W49BE-D can move to channel 29 with the only non-de minimis interference being caused to WUVP-DT channel 29 Vineland, NJ. However, it has been determined that WUVP-DT sold its channel in the Incentive Auction and ceased operation on January 15, 2018; therefore, WUVP-DT will not be adversely impacted by the proposed move of W49BE-D to channel 29. A copy of WUVP-DT's Suspension of Operation Notification to the FCC is attached.
