Dear Applicant:

We are currently processing the above captioned application. Our preliminary analysis indicates the following:

The proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. WSJU-TV – San Juan, PR. – BLCDT-20090217AEH at 11.48%

As imported below: I acknowledge your statement as entered on the copy of the interference study you filed with the application.

NOTE: Station WSJU-TV D31, SAN JUAN, PR File Num. BLCDT20090217AEH was not considered in this TVStudy, as WSJU-TV has relinquished its channel as part of the TV Spectrum Auction, has been off the air since losing its antenna and tower to Hurricane Maria and has certified it will not operate again.

My review of WSJU-TV current status shows that they are licensed and silent, however, there is no indication of their ongoing plans not to go back on the air or that they plan to relinquish their license; therefore, the station is still active and must be protected from interference.

Unless WSJU-TV voluntarily cancels their license, and if you do not amend your application electronically within 30 days from the date of this letter to resolve the above deficiency, we will dismiss your application.
