


UNCONDITIONAL CONSENT AND NON-OBJECTION TO INTERFERENCE

The University of North Carolina ("UNC-TV"), licensee of WUNM-TV, Jacksonville, North Carolina, is seeking a "maximized" construction permit from the FCC to operate its post-transition facility on Channel 28 at 700 kW.

As discussed in the Engineering Exhibit of Chesapeake RF Consultants, LLC, which is attached to WUNM-TV's "maximization" application, UNC-TV's proposed 700 kW operation on Channel 28 is predicted to cause 0.78 percent new interference to WUND-TV, RF Channel 29, Edenton, North Carolina (Fac. ID No. 69292). WUND-TV is, like WUNM-TV, licensed to UNC-TV and the two stations broadcast identical programming. As a result, UNC-TV finds that the predicted new interference by WUNM-TV to WUND-TV will be *de minimis*.

Accordingly, effective on the date hereof, the undersigned, a duly authorized representative of UNC-TV and television station WUND-TV, hereby acknowledges the foregoing and agrees unconditionally to accept (and not object to) the predicted interference to WUND-TV from WUNM-TV's proposed 700 kW operations on Channel 28.
