Dear Licensee,

This letter is to inform you that Eternal Family Network (Eternal Family) the licensee of Station KEFN-CD, St. Louis, Missouri (KEFN-CD) must coordinate the timing of its transition with KETC(TV), St. Louis, Missouri (KETC), in order to minimize viewer confusion and disruption. On March 6, 2018, Eternal Family, was granted authority to transition to its post-incentive auction channel on or before June 1, 2018, with a testing period to commence immediately prior.¹ In the grant letter, the Video Division reserved the right to require KEFN-CD to coordinate the timing of its early transition with KETC,² which is also located in the St. Louis, Missouri, Designated Market Area and requested authority to transition to its post-auction channel on or before June 1, 2018.³ In its waiver request, Eternal Family also committed to conducting such coordination if necessary.⁴ The Video Division has now granted KETC's request and determined that coordination between KETC and KEFN-CD is necessary

Accordingly, we further condition grant of Eternal Family's authority to transition on or before June 1, 2018, on coordinating the timing of its early transition with KETC. This same condition has been placed on our grant of KETC's phase change request.
