The existing tower for WQHA received severe damage due to the impact of Hurricane Maria on September 20, 2017. "Maria" was a near Category 5 hurricane that devastated all of Puerto Rico. Since we submitted our station expenses to the FCC before the hurricane hit Puerto Rico, we did not include any expenses to replace or repair the tower. The destructive ferocity of the storm that hit Puerto Rico was unimaginable.

At this time, we are in the process of repairing the damage caused to the existing WQHA tower by the destructive force of the hurricane. We are replacing about 40 feet of the top section of the tower that did not resist the hurricane wind forces and collapsed to the ground. We will, then, reinforce the tower with new guys and anchor bolts. We hope to finish the tower repairs by the end of April, 2018.

Western New Life Inc. has ordered a new antenna from Jampro Antennas, Inc. and a new transmitter from Rhode and Schwarz that should arrive between April and May. Our plan is to be ready to go on air on our post-auction channel by July 1, 2018.
