

AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT INTERFERENCE IN ORDER TO EXTRICATE
APPLICATION FROM MUTUAL EXCLUSIVITY

According to our TVStudy interference analysis, the facility proposed herein receives predicted interference from a heretofore mutually exclusive proposal in Redding, California (BNPDTL-20090825BPG), in excess of the 2.0% FCC limits. However, the owners of KIXE-DT (and applicant of this proposal) agree to accept the interference caused by the referenced Redding application.

It is also important to note that the amended facility does not cause interference in excess of that allowable under Commission Rules to the Redding application.

As a result, it is believed that the instant amended application can be granted by the Commission.
