KQTA-LD meets the requirements for displacement:

- 1) Its service contour is completely encompassed by co-channel KNTV's move from channel 12 to 13.
- 2) It has been licensed since prior to April 13, 2017 within the service contour of KNTV's post-auction channel 13.

One Ministries, Inc. (OMI) seeks a channel share with the two other displaced San Francisco LPTVs: KMMC-LD and KDTS-LD:

- 1) OMI has already begun engaging Daystar TV about channel sharing on channel 14 between KQTA-LD and KDTS-LD due to lack of additional channels in the San Francisco area
- 2) OMI additionally seeks to channel share with New York Spectrum Holding Company, LLC.'s LPTV: KMMC-LD.
- 3) OMI has chosen a site that would work for all three stations for a three-way equal channel share.
- 4) If any waivers are required to propose a three-way channel share on Sutro tower between the three displacement San Francisco LPTV stations, one is hereby requested.
- 5) The site elevation chosen on Sutro tower has already been studied so as not to cause harmful interferences to land mobile operations on channels 16 and 17. So, there is a very high confidence that the facility at Sutro will be fully harmonized with land mobile communications.

Other than KMMC-LD and KDTS-LD, this proposal does not affect any other displacement applications. Please see attached interference study.
