

Suspension of Operations Explanation

Pursuant to Section 74.763 and of the Commission's rules,¹ KCETLink hereby notifies the FCC that it suspended operations on May 20, 2018 for TV translator K26FT-D located on Gibraltar Peak. K26FT-D suspended operations because a Class A station, KVMM-CD, also located on Gibraltar Peak, was repacked from UHF channel 41 to UHF channel 28 as part of the FCC Voluntary Incentive Auction. Since that time, the input feed to K26FT-D from KCET-DT Los Angeles, CA, also on channel 28, has been disrupted and K26FT-D was forced to go off the air. KCETLink is working on a technical solution to resume operations. KCETLink plans to file separately a request for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for K26FT-D to remain silent for more than 30 days in the event it cannot resume operations within 30 days of when K26FT-D went off the air (*i.e.*, by June 19, 2018).
