**Re: Withdrawal of Petition for Partial Waiver of  
Children's Television Programming Rules, If  
Necessary**

Dear Counsel:

In a filing dated August 3, 2018, you state that Maranatha Broadcasting Company, Inc. (MBC) withdraws its June 15, 2018 request for a partial waiver of section 73.671 of the Commission's Rules. You explain that because of technical refinements, MBC is able to carry its Heroes and Icons subchannel on WFMZ-TV, and that subchannel will now carry three additional hours of children's programming to satisfy the requirement resulting from the broadcast of a separate all-weather channel on WFMZ-TV, eliminating the need for the requested waiver. Therefore, the Request for Partial Waiver of Children's Television Programming Rules, if Necessary filed by Maranatha Broadcasting Company, Inc. on June 15, 2018. IS DISMISSED.
