APPENDIX B CAREER OUTREACH INITIATIVES

August 1, 2016 - July 31, 2017

INTERNSHIPS

KHSL TV station continues to offer internship opportunities for students from California State University Chico, Butte Community College, and Shasta Community College. The station's news internship program is overseen by our News Director and Operations Manager. During this reporting period, 8 students interned at the station. Interns work at the station between 12 and 15 hours a week. Our interns observe and assist with a wide range of broadcast news-related duties, including answering phones, researching stories, writing, field camera work, assisting with the station's social media platforms and producing live newscasts.

JOB SHADOW PROGRAM

The station's job shadow program is done in cooperation with area high schools in our market area. During the reporting period, our Station began a new partnership with Chico's Inspire High School video production program in Chico. The partnership offers job shadowing opportunities for students and mini-broadcast tv seminars. During this period, the news director visited the program's campus classroom to lecture about TV broadcast practices and we hosted three separate job shadow visits for students. One of our News Anchors, a Weather Anchor, and our Digital News Producer participated as mentors during their respective job shadow days.

CAREER DAYS

Our News Anchor was a presenter at a career fair hosted by the Chico Sunrise Rotary Club for high school students in Chico on May 4, 2017. Our Anchor discussed careers in broadcasting and students had the opportunity to ask questions about working in broadcasting.

YOUTH LEADERSHIP FORUM

KHSL TV is a regular participant in the Jackie Faris Youth Leadership forum sponsored by Associated Students of Chico State. The forum is focused on informing young women about a variety of career paths and leadership positions. Our News Anchor participated in the forum on March 14, 2017.

BUTTE COLLEGE WEATHER DAYS AT THE STATION

KHSL TV hosts "Weather Days" at the station that consist of tours of the station and a mini weather and meteorology seminar with our Chief Meteorologist. Students enjoy a tour the station, watch a live news broadcast and get an overview on how the weather department tracks and forecasts weather on a daily basis. During this Reporting Period, we hosted 2 Weather Days on May 12 and May 15 for students from Butte Community College.

SCHOOL STATION TOURS

Our station regularly hosts station tours of local students involved in their respective school broadcast programs. During this Reporting Period, we hosted a tour to Shasta Elementary School on January 18, 2017 and a tour for Chico Inspire High School on April 19, 2017. Each tour included a general station tour and question and answer period with our Weather Anchor during which students had the opportunity to ask questions about careers in broadcasting.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROGRAM

On May 8, 2017, our News Director participated in a special review panel for Butte County's 4-H Scholarship program. The panel reviewed the work of six high school students and interviewed each of them in person. The panel then decided scholarship amounts based on their individual scores. This is the third year in a row that this station has participated in the program.
