

**Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authorization**  
TV Translator Station K47KI-D, Duncan, OK (Facility ID 50195)

Pursuant to *Incentive Auction Task Force and Media Bureau Set Forth Tools Available to LPTV/Translator Stations Displaced Prior to the Special Displacement Window* Public Notice, DA 17-584, MB Docket No. 16-306, GN Docket No. 12-268 (June 14, 2017), and Sections 74.780 and 73.1635 of the FCC's Rules, Oklahoma Educational Television Authority ("OETA"), licensee of noncommercial educational TV translator Station K47KI-D, Durant, Oklahoma, respectfully requests an extension of the Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") granted under temporary call sign K20MG-D to allow operation of the station in accordance with the technical parameters in its pending channel 20 displacement permit application in FCC File No. 0000029423.

OETA filed its initial channel 20 displacement STA application on August 24, 2017 in FCC File No. 0000029460. The FCC granted the STA on September 6, 2017, and extended it in FCC File No. 0000043006, and the STA is currently due to expire on September 6, 2018.

As explained in the initial STA application, OETA filed the channel 20 displacement modification application to seek relief for K47KI-D following receipt of a notification letter from T-Mobile regarding its planned use of the 600 MHz band and the likelihood that K47KI-D would cause harmful interference to T-Mobile's operations. In the June 14, 2017 Public Notice referenced above, the FCC encouraged TV translators such as K47KI-D displaced by 600 MHz band wireless operations to file a displacement permit application accompanied by an STA application.

Therefore, given the upcoming expiration of the K20MG-D STA, and the continued pending status of the corresponding channel 20 displacement permit application, OETA now seeks an STA extension for the continued authorization to operate this Duncan, Oklahoma TV translator on channel 20, while awaiting further action on the permit filing in connection with the processing of filings from the Special Displacement Window.<sup>1</sup> The displacement application in File No. 0000029423 demonstrated that the channel 20 STA facility complies with the FCC's technical and interference rules.

OETA respectfully submits that a grant of an STA extension will serve the public interest by allowing the continued authorization of K47KI-D on its displacement channel despite the 600 MHz band wireless operations in its area and pending permanent authorization. OETA is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates this translator on a noncommercial educational basis.
