

AMENDMENT OF DISPLACEMENT APPLICATION OF W49CZ-D

The licensed facility of W49CZ-D on channel 49 was displaced by the FCC TV repacking, as the station fell out of the core, now below channel 37.

As shown in the included TVStudy interference analysis, the proposed W49CZ-D facility on CH 16 is not predicted to cause impermissible interference to any Full Service or Class "A" TV stations in their post-repack channels. Note that a Cell Size of 0.5 km and a L-R Increment of 0.1 km is used in the TVStudy; this amendment of the previously filed displacement application of W49CZ-D only proposes these different TVStudy L-R parameters that are believed to be more appropriate for the rugged terrain of Puerto Rico. No other change in the operating channel (channel 16), antenna system (pattern, height or orientation) or ERP are proposed, thus no new notification to the Arecibo Observatory is required. This amendment also eliminates interference conflicts with the concurrently filed displacement application of W44DW-D.
