## DISPLACEMENT QUALIFICATION OF WNTE-LD

As shown in the included TVStudy IX analysis of the existing facility of WNTE-LD on Channel 36, it will cause impermissible interference of 1.35% to Full Service station WCCV-TV, 1.91% IX to WIMN-CD, and 13.87% to Full Service station WVOZ-TV, thus the station qualifies for displacement application. No change in the licensed site or antenna height is proposed.

As shown in the included Post Repack TVStudy interference analysis, the proposed WNTE-LD facility on CH 30 is not predicted to cause impermissible interference to any Class A or Full service station. The proposed facility of WNTE-LD is predicted to receive interference levels above 2%, but this IX is accepted.

As all the Puerto Rico TV stations transitioned to their Post-Repack channels on July 31<sup>st</sup>, this application can be granted right away. It should be noted that the amended Post Repack TVStudy IX analysis for WNTE-LD has been run with the L-R parameters of a Cell Size of 0.5 km, and L-R profile increments of 0.1 km.
