South Lane Television Transmitter Specifications

The transmitter in use is made up of a Larcan 8VSB regen transcoder/exciter which is driving a Pineapple Technologies PA500U power amplifier. The amplifier was designed for a power output of 500 watts NTSC peak sync and in this application it is running at 66 watts average digital power which is 13 percent of its analog peak sync rating.

The final output to the transmitting antenna meets the specifications of the stringent mask by way of a Microwave Filter company model 19915 DTV stringent mask five channel combining filter.
