

Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by Georgia Public Telecommunications Commission (GPTC), licensee of W15EK-D, Toccoa, Georgia, and Carolina Christian Broadcasting, Inc. (CCB), licensee of W15EJ-D, Hendersonville, North Carolina. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, CCB has agreed to not make any channel change to its above-referenced application and has consented to GPTC filing a channel change amendment to its above-referenced application, the combined effect of which would eliminate the mutual exclusivity between the two pending applications, the only applications in MX Group 64.

Upon review of your settlement agreement, engineering amendment, and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules. Wherefore, both applications are hereby **GRANTED**.
