

Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by HC2 LPTV Holding, Inc., (HC2), licensee of W25DW-D, Arbury Hills, Chicago; KRCA License, LLC (KRCA), licensee of WESV-LD, Chicago, Illinois; and Venture Technologies Group, LLC (Venture), licensee of WCHU-LD, Chicago, Illinois. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, HC2 has agreed to dismiss its application and will channel share with KRCA on WESV-LD's displacement channel. Venture will amend its application to resolve the mutual exclusivity with KRCA's application. These actions will resolve the mutual exclusivity among the only applications in MX Group 23.

Upon review of your settlement agreement, engineering amendment and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules. Wherefore, the applications for KRCA and Venture are hereby **GRANTED** and the application of HC2 is hereby **DISMISSED**.
