This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc., (Nexstar), licensee of W08AO-D, Canton, North Carolina, and Meredith Corporation (Meredith), licensee of W44CX-D, Sylva, North Carolina. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, Meredith has agreed to accept interference from Nexstar, the effect of which would eliminate the mutual exclusivity between the two pending applications, the only applications in MX Group 79.
