

Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by New York Spectrum Holding Company, LLC (NY Spectrum), licensee of WTXI-LD, Miami, Florida, and KRCA License, LLC (KRCA), licensee of W17DG-D, Miami, Florida. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, NY Spectrum has agreed to dismiss its application and will channel share with KRCA on W17DG-D's displacement channel facilities. These actions will resolve the mutual exclusivity among all of the applicants in MX Group 71.

Upon review of your settlement agreement and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules.
