

Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by CSN International, Inc. (CSN), licensee of KCJY-LP, Twin Falls, Idaho, and Gray Television Licensee, LLC (Gray), licensee of K30QH-D, Burley, etc, Idaho. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, CSN has agreed to amend its application to specify a new channel (16), the effect of which would eliminate the mutual exclusivity between the two pending applications, the only applications in MX Group 78.

Upon review of your settlement agreement, engineering amendment, and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules. Wherefore, both applications are hereby **GRANTED**.
