MOTION TO DISMISS APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

Weigel Broadcasting Co. (“Weigel”), licensee of Class A television station WMEU-CD, Chicago, Illinois (“WMEU”), respectfully seeks to withdraw its request for Commission review of the denial of Weigel’s petition for reconsideration of the grant by the Media Bureau’s Video Division (“Video Division”) of the above-captioned application (the “Application”).

As the Commission Staff is aware, the Application sought authority for LPTV station WSPY-LD (“WSPY”)¹ to move to a new transmitter site located only 81 kilometers from Chicago despite having obtained its original construction permit in a rural filing window that required WSPY to maintain at least a 121 kilometer separation from Chicago. While WMEU would have been adversely affected by the grant of the Application because, as the Application

itself acknowledges, WSPY's proposed facility caused new interference to more than 39,000 WMEU viewers,² intervening circumstances have mitigated such concerns. Specifically, the Chicago television market is being reconfigured following the post-Incentive Auction "repack" scheduled for the Fall of 2019, and the interference to the WMEU viewers will be ameliorated. Accordingly, Weigel and WMEU seek to withdraw its Application for Review.
