Children's Programming Compliance Supplement

During the first and third quarters of 2009, 2010, and the first quarter of 2011, the licensee had conducted its annual Sharathon fundraiser, which preempted several core program episodes on KQUP, resulting in the reduced amount of core children's programming of less than three hours per week under Section 73.671(e)(1). However, the licensee in this supplemental showing is demonstrating that the station KQUP aired a package of different types of educational and informational non-core programming that, when added to its core programming, demonstrates a level of commitment to education and information that is at least equivalent to airing three hours of core programming.

This commitment is shown by the following one-half hour programs which were directed towards youth (tweens and teens):

The Ramp (10:30 pm PST on Saturday)

Check the Sound (10 pm PST on Saturday and Sundays)

Acquire the Fire (11:30 pm PST on Saturdays)

In the aggregate, these non-core E/I program episodes represent an average of an additional 1.69 hours per week of children's E/I programming (22 hours of programming over the 13 week quarter) which more than offsets the "shortfall" below the 3 hour processing guideline. In other words, when the non-core E/I program episodes are considered along with the core program episodes, the average number of hours of E/I programming was at least equivalent to the 3 hour processing guideline.

For the third quarter of 2011, an additional program was aired called *Travel the Road*, which aired at 3:30 pm PST on Saturdays, which resulted in an additional 25.5 hours of programming for this quarter, or an average of 1.96 hours per week.

For the first and third quarters of 2012 and 2013, the following programs aired resulting in an additional 33 hours of programming, which would be an average of 2.54 hours per week:

The Ramp (10:30 pm PST on Saturdays)

Check the Sound (10 pm PST on Saturdays and Sundays)

Acquire the Fire (11:30 pm PST on Saturdays)

Travel the Road (1 pm PST on Saturdays)

Global Ventures (11 pm PST on Fridays)

The Licensee respectfully submits that the entire package of programming, when the non-core E/I program episodes are considered along with the core program episodes, aired on KQUP throughout the license period and, more specifically, during the first and third quarters of 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013, met or exceeded the station's obligations under the Children's Television Act of 1990 ("CTA") and demonstrates a level of commitment to educating and informing children that is at least equivalent to airing three hours per week of core programming.

Accordingly, Word of God Fellowship, Inc., Licensee of Station KQUP, Pullman, WA respectfully submits that it has complied with its children's programming obligations.
