WFUN STA Justification

WFUN-LD, Miami, FL, facility ID 60542, (“WFUN”) files this application to request a channel sharing STA to continue a Channel Sharing Agreement previously approved by the Commission for the pre-repack channel of WFUN’s sharing partner. WFUN vacated channel 48 pursuant to a T-Mobile Notification of Intent to Begin 600MHz Operations dated May 10, 2018. WFUN timely filed a displacement application, but WFUN cannot move to its new channel, channel 20, at this time because its displacement application has been found to be mutually exclusive with two other applications.

Pending a resolution of WFUN’s displacement application, the station entered into a Channel Sharing Agreement with WPMF-CD, Miami, FL, facility ID 30129 (“WPMF”). (LMS lists the station as WBEH-CD but also indicates that the station began using the call sign WPMF-CD on January 3, 2014; the Channel Sharing Agreement, which is attached to this Application, indicates that WFUN entered an agreement with WPMF.)

WFUN previously requested, and the Commission granted, a Channel Sharing STA. *See* LMS File No. 0000062917. That STA will expire on April 24, 2019. At the time of the initial STA, WPMF was operating on its pre-repack channel 38. WPMF has now been repacked and is operating on channel 17. WFUN files this application to request continuing and renewed authority to operate pursuant to its Channel Sharing Agreement with WPMF.
