Request for Extension of Time to Resolve Interference

KHQ, Incorporated ("KHQ") is currently the licensee of Digital TV Translator K18DT-D, Coeur D'Alene, Idaho. The station must relocate to a different channel as part of the Commission's broadcast repack process to allow full-service television station KSPS-TV to move to Channel 18 by mid-August.

The stations in the Spokane, Western Washington, Northern Idaho area have coordinated the repack process through SBE Chapter 21. The plan calls for KHQ's station to move to channel 17 by early summer, and for KWSU-TV, Pullman, WA, to have vacated channel 17 for channel 33 before now. See, KWSU-TV's construction permit granted 10/09/2018 (File number 0000050440, for Facility ID 71024). However, KWSU-TV has not yet cleared channel 17, which results in the level of interference noted in the Commission's interference letter of April 24, 2019 (Reference # 1800E3-RLG). KHQ believes that once channel 17 has been vacated, engineering adjustments can cure the interference to K46HZ-D in Bonners Ferry, ID.

KHQ is working closely with its consulting engineers at Cohen, Dippell and Everist, P.C. and with SBE, Chapter 21 to solve the problem, but will need some additional time. Accordingly, KHQ respectfully requests an extension of an additional **30 Days** to amend its application (until June 24, 2019).

Grant of this extension will allow the stations in the Western Washington and Northern Idaho region to proceed in an orderly fashion to comply with the Commission's repack process without causing loss of broadcast service to the public.
