**Re: WEDE-CD Post-Auction Transition Schedule and the Chicago, Illinois Market**

Dear Mr. Stroud:

I am following up on our prior conversation regarding the possible early transition of repacked television stations in the Chicago market. The early transition in the Chicago market would facilitate WCPX's early transition to channel 34, the same channel presently used for WEDE-CD in Arlington Heights, IL and WISN-TV in Milwaukee, WI.

WCPX-TV currently is assigned to Phase 8 but, because the Phase 8 deadlines fall in the winter of 2020, WCPX-TV would like to transition to channel 34 by the end of Phase 6, along with the other Chicago stations.

Your station WEDE-CD (and other Chicago stations) will still begin post-auction channel equipment tests on September 7, 2019 and transition on October 18, 2019, pursuant to the Phase 6 schedule. I am sure our engineering teams will work closely to coordinate the transition schedule for all affected stations in the market. It is understood that WCPX-TV will not transition to Channel 34 until it is first vacated by WEDE-CD and WISN-TV. Of course, this proposed transition schedule is contingent upon WCPX-TV having obtained the FCC's consent for WCPX's transition plan.
