

Discrimination Complaints

A complaint alleging sexual and age discrimination was filed against the licensee of the stations by Jean Eury, a former Account Executive, on September 9, 2014 at the Maryland Commission on Civil Rights (MCCR No. 1411-0464) and the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (Charge No. 12F-2014-00528). On August 26, 2015, the Commission issued a notice that her Charge was dismissed without prejudice at her request, and this matter is closed.

Eury filed suit in Montgomery County Circuit Court, *Eury v. iHeartMedia Entertainment, Inc.*, Case No. 408211-V in the Circuit Court for Montgomery County, MD on August 20, 2016. iHeartMedia removed Plaintiff's Complaint to the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland on November 5, 2015 in *iHeartMedia + Entertainment, Inc. v. Jean Eury*, Civil No. 8:15-cv-03346 (PWG). The matter was settled on March 22, 2016 and is closed.

Rajan Patel filed a complaint alleging disability discrimination against the licensee with the New York Division of Human Rights (NYDHR Case No. 10198339) on December 5, 2018. iHeartMedia filed a Request to Review Jurisdiction and Dismiss the Charge based on the NYDHR's lack of jurisdiction. iHeartMedia also filed a Statement of Position on December 19, 2018. The matter remains pending.
