

**AUXILIARY ANTENNA EXHIBIT**

Digital Television Station KSTC-TV, Minneapolis, Minnesota (the “Station”), has a licensed auxiliary (backup) antenna in addition to its main facility. It does not, however, require that auxiliary antenna to be able to broadcast on its post-repacked channel in order to have begun operating on its post-repacked channel, as the Station recently has transitioned its main facility to its new channel. *See* LMS File No. 0000034690 (Station’s license to cover application on Channel 30 for main facility). Specifically, the Station has begun operating on its new channel (Channel 30) and has terminated operations on its former channel (Channel 45). Accordingly, the Station has responded “no” to the query “Does the Station require use of a new auxiliary antenna system?”

However, for avoidance of doubt, the Station does intend to transition its auxiliary antenna to Channel 30 at some point in the near future. As that work is not essential to the Station’s commencement of operations on its new channel on its main facility, however, the Station has responded no to the auxiliary antenna question, as noted above.
