

### **Request for Extension**

Pursuant to the Media Bureau's Public Notice,<sup>1</sup> America-CV Station Group, Inc. ("America-CV"), the licensee of WJWN-TV, San Sebastian, Puerto Rico (Facility ID No. 58342) ("Station"), requested an extension of its Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for WJWN-TV to remain silent beyond the first anniversary of it going off the air due to destruction caused by Hurricane Maria.<sup>2</sup> The Commission granted the extension request on September 26, 2018.

On March 5, 2019, America-CV requested a further extension of its Silent STA to install and test WJWN-TV's new antenna and transmitter, as well as to complete the electrical wiring at the site.<sup>3</sup> The Commission granted the extension request on March 7, 2019.

During the past several months, America-CV and its engineers have worked diligently in completion installation and testing of WJWN-TV's new antenna and transmitter, as well as completion of electrical and wiring at the site. America-CV anticipates that it will be able to resume on-air operations of WJWN-TV on its post-auction Channel 33 before the expiration of its Silent STA on September 27, 2019. As a matter of precaution, however, America-CV requests a further extension of WJWN-TV's Silent STA should it fail to return the station to on-air operations by the Silent STA expiration date.

Grant of this extension request is clearly in the public interest as it will allow WJWN-TV to resume its service to the residents of Puerto Rico when America-CV is able to recover from the difficulties resulting from Hurricane Maria.
