	<b>Type of Recruitment Initiative (Menu Selection)</b>	<b>Brief Description of Activity</b>
1	Mentoring Programs (Sales Executives, Accounting and Traffic Department, Technicians)	With the passage of Hurricane Maria for Puerto Rico on September 20, 2017, all the management employees, sales executives, accountants, the traffic department, recording technician and station engineer had to contend with a lack of public communications, telephones, internet, mobile phones and the like. We had to return to manual entry of information and the use of analogous methods of communication. We had no internet, no electricity (we were working with a diesel plant for many months), and only analogue land line telephones worked. It was a unique experience where we all learned to use the old technology to keep the community informed. Hundreds of manual sales had to be written manually and the traffic, recording and accounting departments were in charge of conducting this work. Little by little, a year after the passage of the Hurricane, we are returning to normal operations and continuing with mentoring programs.
2	Training Programs	With the passage of Hurricane María in Puerto Rico on September 20, 2017, all communications were affected and for a long time there was no electricity or water in most of the Island. All efforts were to help the citizens and all the seminars and activities were canceled. A year after

		<p>the hurricane, we are returning to normalcy. As during last year, Axel Cruz, a technician with the supervision of the General Manager, Ada Ramos, broadcast six programs from the Dominican Republic to our radio stations WKJB and WPRA (July, 5 thru July12, 2018). All transmissions were successful. The broadcast was performed by a combination of internet and telephone, because we have problems with the internet in our station WPRA.</p>
	Internship	<p>WKJB &amp; WPRA maintain an informal internship program in the areas of technical production and promotions. This program is conducted under the direct supervision of the General Manager. The internship program has been offered to Pontificia Universidad Católica of PR, Mayaguez Campus. During this period, however, there were no students. Classes in the universities were cancelled during and after the passage of Hurricane Maria. They had to make adjustments this affected the time and frequency when students could come to do their practice in our radio stations.</p>
3	Job Fairs/Job Banks/Internet Programs	<p>WPRA has a Facebook page (La Primera Mayaguez) where we list our postal address, fax number and e-mail for the public who are interested in sending their resumes. WKJB opened a fan page WKJB 710AM and an internet page <a href="http://www.wkjb710.com">www.wkjb710.com</a> too. WPRA has a Twitter account. Both radio stations are in all media networks. With Hurricane Maria, all communications failed. There was no internet for many months, but one year after we are finally returning to running the operations in a routine and normal basis.</p>
