

Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by Word of God Fellowship, Inc. (WGF), licensee of WPXU-LD, New York, New York; and Venture Technologies Group, LLC (Venture), licensee of W31EF-D, New York, New York. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, WGF has agreed to dismiss its application and to the grant of Venture's application. Following the grant of the settlement, the parties have agreed that WPXU-LD will seek to channel share W31EF-D's granted displacement channel. These actions will resolve the mutual exclusivity among the applications.

Upon review of your settlement agreement and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, and Section 73.3525 of the Commission's rules. Wherefore, the application of Venture (File No. 0000054807) is hereby **GRANTED** and the application of WGF (File No. 0000051706) is hereby **DISMISSED**.
