Online Public Inspection File Compliance

Centro Colegial Cristiano, Inc. (“Centro Colegial”), licensee of Stations WVID-FM, Anasco, Puerto Rico, Facility ID No. 10955, cannot certify that all documents required by the Commission’s online public inspection file rules were timely uploaded. Centro Colegial uploaded its Issue/Program Lists and corporate documents after the deadline set by the Commission for the transition to online public inspection files. Centro Colegial regrets this oversight and takes seriously its obligation to comply with FCC rules and deadlines. Transitioning to the OPIF created a significant administrative burden for small stations like WVID. Moreover, as the Commission knows, Hurricane Maria caused significant hardship for stations operating in Puerto Rico, including dealing with clean-up and rebuilding efforts on the island for months after the storm. Going forward, however, Centro Colegial believes that the administrative burden of complying with the OPIF rules will be diminished now that the transition is complete. Moreover, Centro Colegial has put in place additional processes to ensure that it timely complies the Commission’s OPIF rules.

In addition, WVID does not have an Issue/Program List for the fourth quarter of 2017. WVID was off the air at the time due to Hurricane Maria; therefore, there was no programming to report on an Issue/Program List.
