Request for Silent Special Temporary Authority

TV Translator Station W32DS-D, Maplewood, OH (Facility ID 25069)

Greater Dayton Public Television, Inc. (“GDPTV”), licensee of TV translator station W32DS-D, Maplewood, Ohio, respectfully requests Silent Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to maintain the station’s off-air status for more than thirty (30) days.

By online filing on October 24, 2019 in FCC File No. 0000087297, GDPTV notified the FCC of W32DS-D’s temporary suspension of operations, as of October 14, 2019, in connection with the build-out of facility modifications and re-channeling pursuant to a granted displacement construction permit issued under call sign W25FI-D in FCC File No. 0000078087 (modifying the displacement permit in File No. 0000054368).

W32DS-D is being displaced by re-packed full-service television stations, and as a result is in the process of moving to channel 25 pursuant to its granted modification permit. The translator’s channel 32 operation was turned off on October 14, 2019 to allow for removal of the channel 32 antenna and installation of the channel 25 antenna and related equipment. GDPTV hoped to return the translator to service on channel 25 within a matter of days, but the tower crew encountered a mounting problem with the new antenna which has delayed the completion of installation. This process is not yet completed as of this date, such that GDPTV now requests Silent STA for the current off-air status.

A grant of Silent STA will serve the public interest by authorizing W32DS-D’s silent status in connection with the post-incentive auction repack process and pending the completion of the new antenna mounting as needed to restore operation on the translator station’s authorized new channel.

GDPTV operates this station a noncommercial educational basis to rebroadcast its co-owned full service noncommercial educational broadcast station WPTD(TV), Dayton, Ohio. GDPTV is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the FCC’s rules, and is exempt from FCC regulatory fees pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the FCC’s rules.
