

**FCC Form 2100 – Schedule 303-S**  
**Adherence to Minimum Operating Schedule Exhibit**

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Since Philip von Kahle, Assignee for the Benefit of Creditors, acquired control of WFFG(AM), Marathon, Florida (Facility ID No. 65664) (“WFFG”) on June 4, 2018,<sup>1</sup> WFFG was silent for 2 separate periods – each exceeding 30 consecutive days:

**1<sup>st</sup> Period of Silence – June 4, 2018 to April 28, 2019**

On May 8, 2018, WFFG went silent due a dispute between WFFG’s former licensee, Choice Keys Corporation (“Choice Keys”), and the landlord of the station’s transmitter site.<sup>2</sup> On May 15, 2018, Choice Keys filed a Notification of Suspension of Operations and Request for Silent Special Temporary Authority (“STA”), which the Commission granted on June 4, 2018.<sup>3</sup>

After acquiring the station, Mr. Kahle filed a request for extension of WFFG’s STA to Remain Silent pending the sale of the station and the continued inability to use WFFG’s transmitter site.<sup>4</sup> The Commission granted the STA extension request on December 18, 2018.<sup>5</sup>

WFFG resumed operations on April 28, 2019 under facilities authorized by STA.<sup>6</sup>

**2<sup>nd</sup> Period of Silence – May 2, 2019 – Present**

On May 2, 2019, WFFG again went silent due to a power failure at its transmitter site.<sup>7</sup> On May 7, 2019, Mr. Kahle filed a Notification of Suspension of Operations and Request for STA for WFFG to remain silent, which the Commission granted on May 23, 2019.<sup>8</sup> As of the date of this Application, WFFG remains silent as it remains uncertain whether power will be restored to the island on which WFFG’s transmitter site is located.
