

Online Public Inspection File

Since Michael A. Costello acquired majority control of Fleur de Lis Broadcasting, Inc. (“Fleur de Lis”), licensee of WTIK-FM, Galliano, Louisiana (Facility ID No. 8382) (“WTIK-FM”), on March 7, 2013,¹ Fleur de Lis failed to comply with certain Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) requirements for WTIK-FM:

Section 73.3613 Contracts and Documents. Fleur de Lis inadvertently failed to upload copies of contracts and other documents required under Section 73.3613 of the Commission’s rules to WTIK-FM’s OPIF by the March 1, 2018 deadline. The missing contracts and documents have now been uploaded to WTIK-FM’s OPIF.

Q2 2013 – Q3 2017 Issues/Programs Lists. Fleur de Lis inadvertently failed to upload WTIK-FM’s Q1 2013 – Q3 2017 Issues/Programs Lists to WTIK-FM’s OPIF by the March 1, 2018 deadline. The missing lists have now been uploaded to WTIK-FM’s OPIF.

Political File Reports. Fleur de Lis inadvertently failed to upload several of WTIK-FM’s Political File Reports immediately to WTIK-FM’s OPIF. The reports have now been uploaded to WTIK-FM’s OPIF.
