

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

The KAIX Construction Permit (File Number 0000105704) contains two Special Operating Conditions:

1. *The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.*
2. ****NOTE TO PERMITTEE*** Notwithstanding the grant of this construction permit or the expiration date specified herein, your station's license will automatically expire as a matter of law on November 8, 2020 if the station has not resumed broadcasting before that time. See Pub. Law No. 104-104, 110 Stat. 56, Section 403 (1) (1996) and Order, Silent Station Authorizations, FCC 96-218 (released May 17, 1996). See also Public Notice, Expedited Processing of Applications Filed By Silent Stations, DA 96-818 (May 22, 1996). Upon resumption of broadcasting, the licensee must notify the Commission. This notice will be in addition to an application for a license to cover this permit.*

1. EMF in coordination with other users of the site agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna, from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
