During the past two years, station managers and other employees have spoken to local school guidance counselors about radio opportunities, met with high school classes to discuss radio careers, and participated in high school career days. Station personnel have also spoken to teachers at the local schools career center about radio opportunities for their students to help the teachers prepare for classes.

Local students have been invited to the station to learn about broadcasting through “shadowing” station personnel and through group meetings with station personnel. Students and members of local community groups have learned about broadcast jobs through tours offered by the station.

Station personnel have also attended and participated in local job fairs to inform potential applicants about broadcasting careers.

While hiring opportunities at the stations have been extremely limited, the stations continue to engage in community outreach to provide education and careers in broadcasting.
