

WUXP-TV Multicast Streams

WUXP Licensee, LLC (“Licensee”), licensee of WUXP-TV, Nashville, Tennessee (Facility ID 9971; RF Channel 21), is filing this application to (1) commence ATSC 3.0 operations from WUXP-TV’s current facility and (2) identify a host station that will simulcast WUXP-TV’s programming in ATSC 1.0 format.

As indicated in the Form 2100 application, Licensee proposes to simulcast WUXP-TV’s primary stream (affiliated with *MyNetwork*) in ATSC 1.0 format on commonly controlled **WZTV(TV), Nashville, Tennessee** (Facility ID 418; RF Channel 20).

To ensure that WUXP-TV’s transition to ATSC 3.0 will not result in any loss of over-the-air programming to viewers, WZTV will also serve as the ATSC 1.0 host for WUXP-TV’s multicast streams affiliated with *GetTV* and *Comet TV*.

The PSIP virtual channels for each of WUXP-TV’s program streams described herein will remain unchanged. Accordingly, WUXP-TV’s streams will be hosted in ATSC 1.0 as follows:
