Renewal Certifications

The station was the subject of a long-form transfer of control, which consummated on November 17, 2017. *See Entercom Communications and CBS Radio*, 32 FCC Rcd 9380 (MB 2017). In accordance with the Instructions to this Form 2100 – Schedule 303-S, the certifications made in this application cover only the period of time from and after such date.

FCC Violations

On July 22, 2020, the FCC’s Media Bureau released an Order and related Consent Decree which settled and fully resolved matters involving Licensee’s certain violations of the Political File Statute and Rule (as defined in the Consent Decree). *See FCC DA 20-775*.

Public Inspection File

As part of Licensee’s internal public file review practices, as well as in connection with preparing to submit this license renewal application, Licensee discovered that certain documents, including those identified below, were either missing from the online public file, not uploaded in a timely manner, or had a technical error.

All missing documents have since been uploaded to the public file. The missing and/or late documents included:

- Quarterly Issues Programs Report: The Q1 2019 quarterly issues/programs report was timely uploaded to the file on April 1, 2019, as the screenshot below reflects. However, a technical error with the online file prevented the report from being viewable to the public. Licensee has re-uploaded the report to the file and confirmed that the report can be viewed.
